Coverage will include two (2) complete scheduled semi-annual PUMP CHEK inspections on the above

equipment. Each visit includes the Labor and Travel Charge listed below (Parts are extra). Any additional work beyond the contracted amount of hours would be billed at our standard Time & Material rates.

STH to perform the following during this service; Check and record performance of each pump: Check amperage draw at "shut off" and flow. Check and MEG the motors#1 #2 #3 Test pump "shut off" pressure. Compare performance of pump. Check if Rotation is correct. Yes Check solenoid purge valve operation. Check pressure switch sequencing for operation and record settings. Check minimum run timer operation. Check system low pressure alarm. Check low pump suction alarm. Check system pressure accumulator tank for condition. Clean pencil strainers and all pressure regulating valves. Operate "lag" pumps on systems without auto alternation. Check motor bearings and lubricate as necessary. Check for leaks in mechanical seals and pitot connections. Check all electrical connections. Adjust pressure regulating valves as necessary. Check all status lighting and pressure gauges. Open, inspect, and clean PRV's. Replace internal parts on PRV's (parts are extra), if needed. Take Pictures of all items that are not normal. There is an additional charge for all parts used and for labor beyond 4 hours per visit for a **Duplex and 6 hours for a Triplex system.**
